Historic town

A species commonly planted during the 1860s and 1870s. This tree is a fine example and has grown surprisingly well. The environment is considerably different from the mountain forests of the Sierra Nevada Range in California.

May 2009 The tree has been in decline over the past 5 years and in Nov 2007 the fungus Botryosphaeria was detected. The extreme dry and hot conditions over the past 10-12 years has severely stressed the tree and it is now dead.
