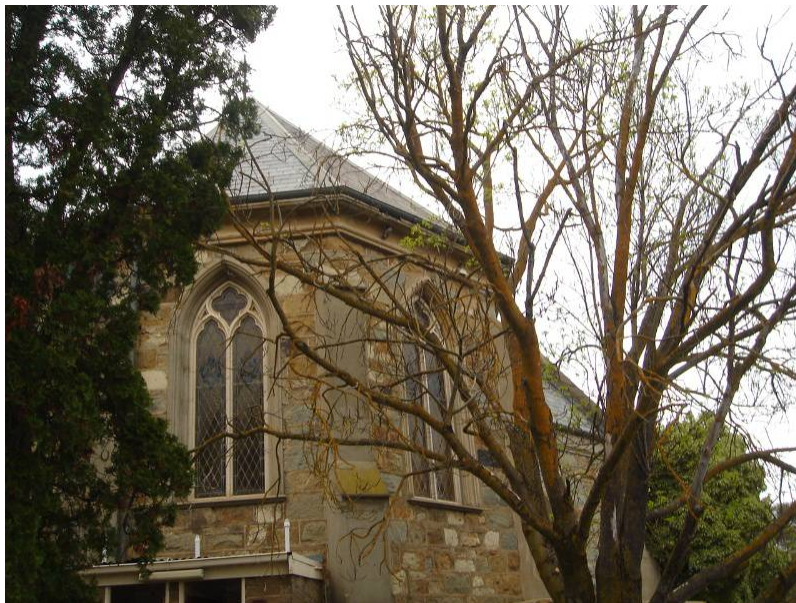

The church is the oldest existing church in the region, and it is interesting architecturally, except that the recent additions detract from its character. The presbytery is a functional unit with the church. (Tansley, 1978)
