What is Significant?

'The Gables of Glen Harrow' house and garden, 24 Glen Harrow Heights Road, Belgrave.

How is it Significant? 'The Gables of Glen Harrow', 24 Glen Harrow Heights Road, Belgrave, is of local aesthetic and historical significance.

Why is it significant?

Of aesthetic significance because it is a fine example of a substantial Victorian-era country dwelling and garden. (RNE criterion E.1)

Of historic significance as one of the oldest houses built at the time of the original Belgrave settlement. Association with Cole (RNE criterion D.2)

Description
